We Are Called To Live Our Faith ... Beyond Sunday**Sponsoring Faith — We Are Making A Difference**

This weekend we are celebrating the Confirmation of our 8th grade students. They are well prepared, but will need our continuing support in the challenge of living a life of faith—here and now. Pray for them always! And if you can join with them for this celebration at the 10:30 am Sunday Mass, please do so.

Proudly this week I was reminded of the value and importance of our support for the young members of our Church. Three high school students of our parish have been recognized for their knowledge and practice of our faith.

Brianna Prater has been chosen as a Mission Model for the students of Incarnate Word Academy. She is an excellent listener and inspires others by her academic effort, by developing her talents in music and art, and by serving as a senior leader for the freshman retreat program. In this she fulfills the IWA mission of promoting human dignity, thereby empowering themselves and others to make a positive impact on our world.

In addition, I was notified of two other students of our parish who have received scholarships from the Annual Catholic Appeal for essays they have written on the importance of stewardship in our Catholic Church.

Kirsten Pfitzner wrote that *“the Church ... is a community of kind and loving people doing good in the world.”* She has learned that the Annual Catholic Appeal *“helps create a balance in our society and provides assistance to people and the troubles in their lives.”* And the importance of *“being able to give up something you want for the greater good”*.

Emily Mach, also of Trinity High School, wrote, *“Since Baptism, God has called all Catholics to be his stewards ... helping and caring for others no matter who they are or what they have been through.”* *“We must recognize & use the gifts God has given us to encourage and welcome others.”*
