**A Covenant of Forgiveness**

**"I am with you always!"** This is one of the most dominant Scriptural themes for our life of faith. When the People of God remember this, they are hopeful and experience themselves as the Sacrament of the love of God. When they forget, they are anxious, fearful, and self-concerned. During Advent Christians strive to deepen their awareness and sureness that Jesus is the fulfillment of this promise - that in our life on Earth we are never alone.

I have come to deeply believe that the best definition of **"forgiveness"** is **"unconditional love"**. We all know when we experience this kind of love. And when we do we also know that God's promise, **"I am with you always!"** is trustworthy. We experience the joy of our own goodness. We desire to try again to explore the boundaries of generous love for others.

Curiously, whenever we pray in The Lord's Prayer **"... forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us ..."**, aren't we really defining the boundaries of the love of God on our behalf? Wouldn't we want those limits to be as large as possible for ourselves and each other!

This Advent I would invite every member of our parish to a review of life that would include celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation. As a Sacrament we believe that it's an opportunity to experience the real presence of Jesus Christ - another way and time to receive Christ into your life.

**Going to Confession - It's Easier Than You Think!**

Some things to remember: First, every priest will coach you through it, if you think you've forgotten. Second, God doesn't really care about how long it's been. God only wants a chance to love you more. Third, can you ever get enough of the love of God? Sinners great and small are always welcome. Finally, use these three questions to prepare:

- What am I most sorry for?
- What do I need God's help with?
- What do I most want to thank God for?

Now you're all set to go! Take a look at the reconciliation schedule to the right and make a plan for yourself and your family. Also, encourage your friends to go to confession. Witness to your experience! Positively let them know what they're missing, and the real difference a review of life can make for all of us.


