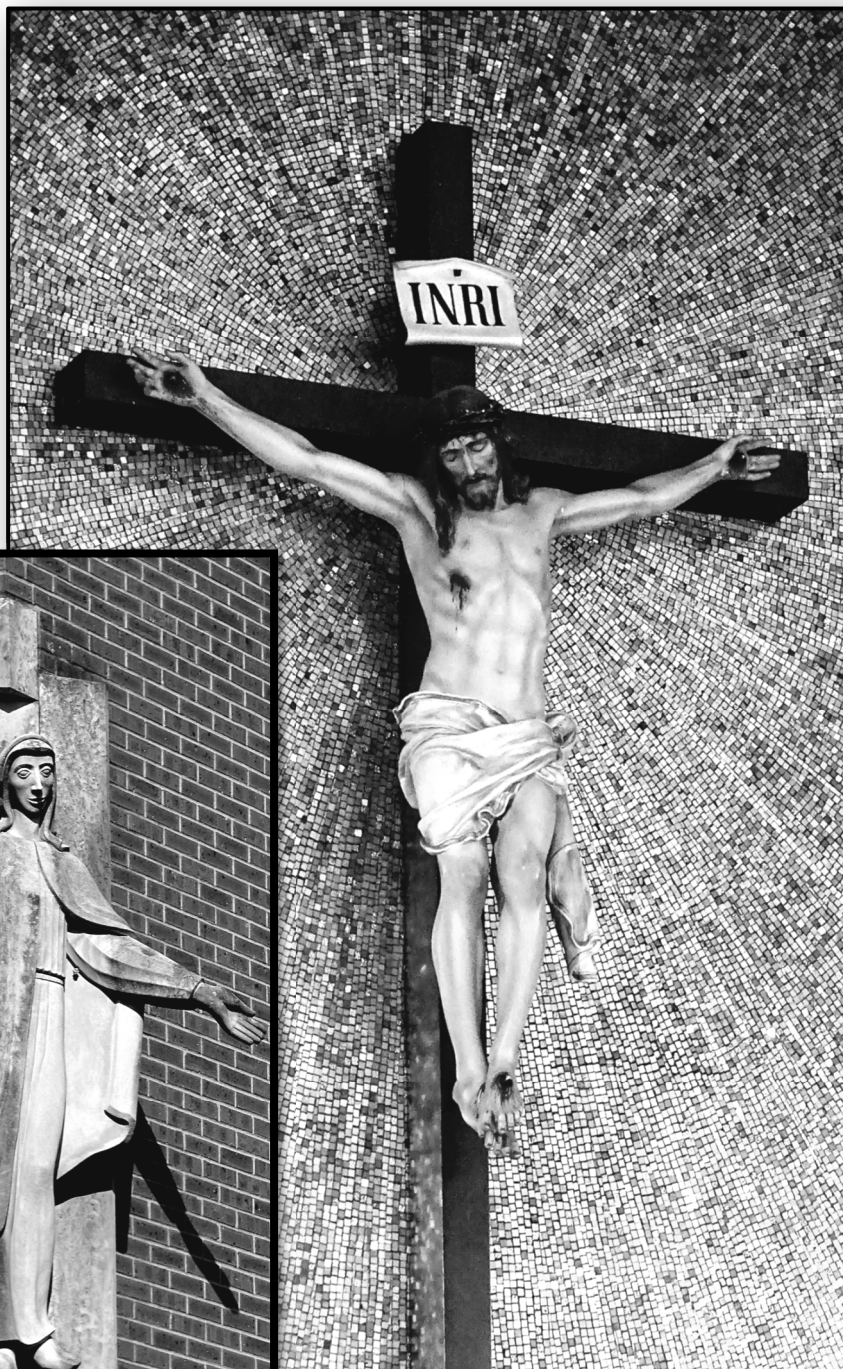

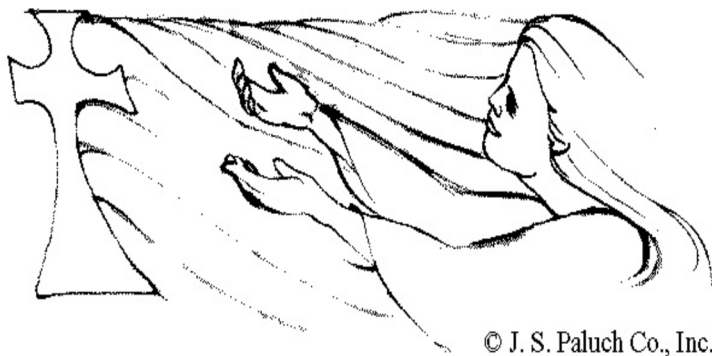

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THE HEAVENLY BANQUET

The mountain of the Lord described in today's first reading is a place where there is no more hunger, no more weeping, and no more division of any kind. We need to pause and ponder these images every now and then, especially given the fact that we live in such a fractured world. The responsorial psalm continues to paint a picture of a place where only goodness and kindness flourish. These readings describe the heavenly banquet, to which God calls each of us through baptism and continues to call us throughout our lives. Let us "RSVP" to God's invitation and live our lives consistent with gospel values so that one day we will be welcomed to the table of the kingdom.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

In 1971, the Vatican Congregation for Divine Worship completed a survey of the presidents of the national liturgical commissions around the world. How were children doing in the liturgical reform? Probably to their surprise, the cardinals learned of special weekday Masses for children designed to teach them how to participate on Sunday, Masses with separate components for children. The decision was made quickly to develop adaptations for Masses where children were a majority of the assembly. Changes would include a simpler structure, understandable texts, a simplified Lectionary, more active participation, and most surprisingly, new Eucharistic Prayers. By 1973 the work was done, and with very specific advice from Pope Paul VI, including the need for two new Eucharistic Prayers, the *Directory for Masses with Children* was published on December 20, a timely Christmas gift for the children of the world.

The prayers are the first to be written fresh in a modern language—not Latin, but French and German—then translated into English, Italian, and Spanish. With a sense of caution, these new prayers were approved for three years, until 1977, but it soon became apparent that they had truly been embraced.

September Liturgy Committee Meeting

Adult Education: The Eucharist Study/Prayer Sessions are going well with about 19 to 20 participants. The session begins with reflection questions, followed by a teaching period, and then ending with a prayer or ritual. These sessions are led by Deacon George.

Evening Prayer for Faithful Departed: This is scheduled for 11-9-17 at the Church site. Deacon George will then send invitations around the second week of October. It was suggested to also invite people who had lost someone other than in the past year. Refreshments and fellowship will take place before Solemn Evening prayer and will be discussed at the next liturgy meeting.

Communion of Saints Altars: We will again encourage people to send up a picture of a lost loved one. These will be displayed at both worship sites. On the night of the evening prayer, however, all pictures will be moved to the church site where the service is to be conducted. They will then be returned to their original locations for pick up by loved ones at the end of the month.

Adult Servers: We are attempting to put all adult servers (who are agreeable to it) on the weekend mass schedule. It might help fill in the gaps we presently have with mass servers. We see no reason why adults and children cannot be scheduled to serve together. Perhaps we can even get servers to serve at both worship sites. Donna Forrest will begin work on this.

Lenten Reconciliation Service: We will discuss this more thoroughly after Deacon George talks with Father Mike. Father Mike wants it to be more than just a communal penance service. He would like it to be more like a mini-mission, possibly with a speaker.

Important Dates: Some dates to note in November: November 1—All Saints. November 5—Daylight Savings Time ends; starting on 11-11-17 mass will be at 4:00 pm. November 9, 2017—Evening prayer at 7:30 for those who have died with fellowship at 6:45. November 11, 2017—Sacrament of Confirmation during Saturday mass. November 23—Thanksgiving, mass at church site.

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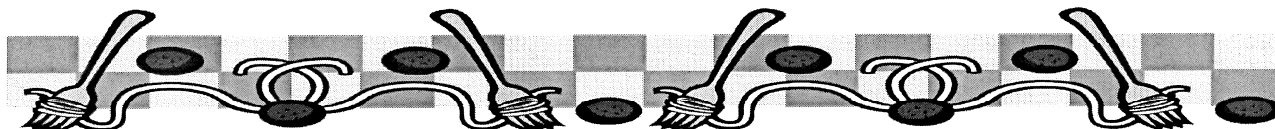
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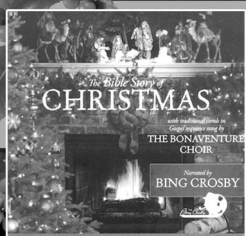
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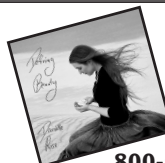
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
