Since Ferguson, and again this past summer and fall in the St. Louis area, we are beginning to realize that racism expresses itself in many different ways. Even when we simply hear the word, we now more immediately think of policies, institutions, laws, and language we use even on a daily basis. Certainly we're becoming more aware that racism is a part of our history here in Missouri, founded on the very social structures that make up society.

As a nation during the 1960's many laws were made against racism, and some things changed. But this question remains: *Have we taken the time, as a people, to really talk to one another about this issue? To overcome the deep divide that continues to exist?* All people, regardless of race, should be treated with dignity and respect. All children, no matter where they reside, should feel safe and should benefit from quality education without having to travel out of their neighborhoods. In the words of Archbishop Carlson, "*We must do better.*"

In my homilies and work with parish leaders, I am trying to keep before us this issue and some very concrete needs resulting from racism. This Lent the Archbishop has asked priests and deacons across the Archdiocese to begin or continue to address the challenge of racism in St. Louis. Most of us have family and friends living outside of North County. Hopefully we will want to share with them our experience of life in North County - so often misperceived and mistaken by others. Hopefully, we will want to grow in our knowledge about racism and talk more with each other, supporting the need for our parish to continue to act on what we know and believe.




