Parish Report from Father Mike

May 27th, 2018 - No. 11

This report focuses on our most recent recommendations to Archbishop Carlson concerning the future of our parish and, in particular, our property and facilities located in Spanish Lake.

Since 2005 **Parish Viability** has been an important concern for all the pastors and parishes of the North County Deanery.

Viable parishes are much more likely to experience the joyful satisfaction and hope of fulfilling the mission of Jesus Christ in the communities we are here to serve.

Since 2015 our parish leaders have tried to stay focused on those characteristics that enable -

Parish Vitality

(having sufficient staff, parish leaders, and volunteers to sustain the ministries, organizations, and activities needed for a parish to accomplish the work of the Church) and

Parish Stability

(practicing good stewardship of our human, financial, and material resources).

STRATEGIC PLANNING & VIABILITY UPDATE

In late **November 2017**, Father Mike and Sr. Mary Lawrence, our school principal, began to consult with the Catholic Education Office and the Archdiocesan Office of Building and Real Estate concerning the future use of the Chapel of Our Lady and former rectory in Spanish Lake. These meetings continued in **January 2018** in preparation for consultations with our School Board, Parish Pastoral Council, and Parish Finance Committee.

The **issues under discussion** included the physical condition and maintenance of these facilities, their current and possible future use, and their value as assets which could be utilized for the mission and viability of our parish.

During **January - March 2018** school and parish leaders met to consider the present and future needs of our school and our parish. As a result of these meetings they made the following **recommendations** to Father Mike which were reported to the parish in the March 18th bulletin -

- ◆ That the Chapel of Our Lady be closed at the end of May and that all parish liturgical celebrations take place at the Parish Church
- ◆ That the school property be legally separated from the property of the Chapel of Our Lady and former rectory and these properties be prepared for sale since alternative uses have not been developed
- ◆ That the school utilize a special Archdiocesan grant to create a worship space within the school building for the coming school years

Accepting these recommendations Father Mike then wrote Archbishop Carlson for his approval which was received in a letter dated May 4th. The Archbishop instructed Father Mike to work with **Father Aaron Nord** to prepare a report for the Archbishop's Consultors and the Council of Priests. At the time of this writing (May 15th) we are anticipating the following timeline of events:


Improving Lives Since 1955 Saint Louis Counseling

There's a new name, but the mission is the same. *Saint Louis Counseling* is the new name of *Catholic Family Services*, chosen to better describe its services and honor our city's namesake. You may have noticed the new signs here or may have read about this in the *St. Louis Review* earlier this month.

The new name maintains our Catholic identity while better reflecting what the agency has been doing for more than 60 years, supporting healing and improved mental health for families and children of all backgrounds through professional counseling and psychiatric services.

St. Louis, King of France, was a mediator. He helped the needy by opening his doors, and he believed in seeking out right and just individuals to bear his thoughts and problems. These are all core components of counseling.

Saint Louis Counseling has 8 locations, one of which is in our **Parish Office Center**. Client services are available for all types of mental health issues, including anxiety, depression, grief/loss issues, marital/relationship problems, addictions, stress arising from abuse or neglect, eating disorders, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD), autism spectrum, disorders and more.



On Thursday, May 17th the Consultors and Council of Priests meet to discuss our report and to make their recommendations to the Archbishop.

Soon After This Meeting the Archbishop makes a final decision that may then be published in *The Review*.

After the Official Publication of the Archbishop's decision Father Mike will begin working with Mr. Randy Rafter, Director of the Office of Building and Real Estate, to market the property for sale.

Father Mike will need the help of parish leaders and volunteers as well as assistance from the Office in the following areas -

- ◆ If necessary, the **property will be surveyed** so that all legal boundaries will be clearly known and recorded
- ◆ An **appraisal of the property's value** will be professionally determined
- ◆ A **contract and realtor with experience** in marketing non-residential commercial properties in North County will be recommended to the parish and engaged by the Archdiocese
- ◆ A **small team** (2-3 parishioners) who can serve as contacts with Father Mike and Randy Rafter concerning **the property's security, maintenance, and any needed repairs** prior to marketing or the completion of the sale

Finally, I want to thank the members of our Pastoral Leadership Team, our Parish Pastoral Council, and our Finance Committee for their careful attention to our parishioners and for their commitment to the welfare, life, and ministry of our parish. Over the past several years their wisdom, guidance, and support have been a real grace in my life. Join me in thanking them for the real blessing they are on our parish.

KEY QUESTIONS FOR A VIABLE PARISH

I invite all parishioners to continue to honestly and reasonably think, pray, and talk about these questions.

Let our parish leaders know what needs attention, including ways you might imagine our parish being reorganized for the sake of our present and future mission in this part of North County.

Do we have sufficient membership to support the organization and work of the Church?

Are we publicly known for our welcoming attitude, effective worship, outreach to the community, and commitment to the religious education and faith formation of our members?


