Statement from the  
Most Reverend Archbishop Robert J. Carlson  
On the Separation of Immigrant Parents and Children

Most Reverend Robert J. Carlson, Archbishop of St. Louis, released the following statement addressing the separation of immigrant parents and children:

Today, I join my brother bishops in the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops in condemning the use of family separation at the U.S./Mexico border as an implementation of the administration's zero tolerance policy. Along with my brother bishops, I understand the need to have secure borders and to ensure that our country remains safe. But, to forcibly separate children from their parents is inhumane, morally unacceptable, and ineffective to the goal of deterrence and safety.

As bishop and pastor to our immigrant community and local Church, I know that parents will do what is best for their children and family, especially in difficult circumstances. Indeed, our Catholic faith and principles teach us to do everything we can to keep our families together, healthy, and safe. Our pastoral accompaniment with the immigrant community has taught us to recognize the root causes of migration, especially those associated with state-sanctioned violence, gang recruitment, poverty, and lack of educational opportunities. We know from our pastoral care and services with the immigrant community that unless governmental policies address these root causes of migration and work to repair our broken immigration system not much will be gained.

As faithful citizens and members of the Catholic Community, we respect the rule of law and its commitment to fair treatment and due process; however, this current tactic being used against our immigrant families is contrary to our Christian principle of respect for the inherent dignity of people and the social responsibility to work for the common good. Furthermore, any policy or strategy that callously commodifies our children fall short of our American ideals and values. As a nation of immigrants, we have a long tradition of welcoming the stranger and the poor and the needy into our way of life. As a people of faith, we remain committed to our Gospel values that speak of compassion and solidarity (Matthew 25:31-46)

In our shared commitment to the common good, I ask the Catholic of this archdiocese and people of good will to write to the President, the Attorney General and members of Congress, to insist that this enforcement practice of separating families come to an end. In particular, I want to ask the Catholic community to pray for the families and their children affected by this enforcement policy, and to remain faithful to our Catholic commitment to welcome and serve our immigrant and refugee communities with the best of our resources. #CatholicsSTL

### **Many Confused Over New Medicare Cards**

As Medicare begins to mail new ID cards to its 60 million members, more than three-quarters of them know little or nothing about the initiative to use newly assigned ID numbers in place of their Social Security number (SSN) as their identification, a new AARP survey reveals.

In addition, 6 in 10 believe they might have to pay for the new card (they don't), according to the survey. That belief could make them vulnerable to scam artists.

In April, individuals new to Medicare began receiving the updated card, which displays a unique combination of 11 letters and numbers, rather than a beneficiary's SSN. Replacing cards for current beneficiaries is a year-long process that began in May. (To learn more about when your card will arrive, go to Medicare.gov/NewCard)

Scammers posing as Medicare representatives are already calling beneficiaries demanding a processing fee. Other fraudsters are telling beneficiaries that they are owed a refund from transactions on their old card and then asking for bank account information to process the reimbursement. Medicare will never ask an enrollee for a bank account number, and no refunds are owed.

AARPs Fraud Watch Network provides more prevention tips and advice on many types of scams, including those involving card replacements. Consumers can also sign up for "Watchdog Alert" emails to get regular updates on new scams.




