Signs, Chapter 2

We remember the Second Vatican Council for giving us back Mass in our own languages. Some of the Council's other achievements are more subtle, and will take longer to bear fruit.

The council met, off and on, from 1962 to 1965, only 20 years after World War II. Many participants at the council could remember World War I and the Russian Revolution. It was the time of the Cold War and the spread of nuclear arsenals. The Cuban Missile Crisis was in 1962. President Kennedy was assassinated in 1963. The council met in Italy, a country still embarrassed by its recent embrace of fascism, and bedeviled by a very active communist party.

Against this bleak backdrop, Vatican II produced a startling, visionary statement about the very nature of the church. An old guard on the council's staff had proposed a routine "schema" for a declaration on the church. Catholics right, Protestants wrong. Free-thinkers dangerous, Reds bad -- that kind of thing. It contained real truths, but it wasn't going to change anything for the better in the church or in the world. The bishops sent that draft back to committee, a new committee. The document they then proposed, and that the bishops adapted and finally adopted, began, "Jesus Christ is the Light of Nations." Now we know that dogmatic constitution as *Lumen Gentium*, its first two words in Latin. Our parish named its elementary school after it.

Here's one groundbreaking statement in *Lumen Gentium*:

God has gathered together as one all those who, in faith, look upon Jesus as the author of salvation and source of unity and peace. God has established them as the Church, so that, for each and all, the Church may be the visible sign of that saving unity.

That's one very important thing that the church is: a sign to the world that saving unity is possible. To a world driven and riven by competition, mistrust, and aggression, we're a sign that something more humane is possible: unity, indeed saving unity.

Saving unity finds expression, is "signed," in many ways. Three local examples:

- A newcomer at mass gets a personal welcome, an introduction, a smile, a handshake.
- Regularly and reliably, hungry neighbors get food from our Saint Vincent de Paul.
- Catholic children, and children who will probably never be Catholic, together receive a solid education and build good character at Christ, Light of the Nations School.

How do you help the church express its nature as sign of saving unity?

A new kind of sign is, or will be soon, front and center outside our church (on the steps facing Ashbrook Drive). Look for it, and watch this space for more information.



REST IN THE LORD
