

SUMMARY OF ANNUAL FINANCIAL RESULTS

We have provided for your information and review the financial statements for Holy Name of Jesus Parish and Christ Light of the Nations School for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018. We have also enclosed the fiscal year end statements for our investment accounts that contain our parish reserve funds and the statements for the education endowment funds known as the Monsignor Poelker/Father Robertson Endowment Fund.

The life of a Christian steward lived in imitation of the life of Christ, is challenging, even difficult in many ways; but both here and hereafter it is charged with intense joy.

Stewardship: A Disciples Response, Pastoral Letter of U.S. Bishops

Our parish revenues decreased from last year due to a reduction in offertory contributions and bequests. With the closure of the Chapel of Our Lady site we experienced a loss of contributing parishioners. In addition, we had a large bequest last year and received much smaller bequest contributions this year. Our expenditures were down slightly due to lower contributions to Christ Light of the Nations school, lower payroll and professional fees due to loss of staffing.

Christ Light of the Nations school results showed a decrease in tuition from a reduction in enrollment. Grant revenues from the Archdiocese and other sources were comparable to the prior year with a small decrease from Holy Name of Jesus support. This overall reduction in revenue was accommodated without a reduction in staffing. This all resulted in a small gain for the year overall.

Our reserve fund balances continue to provide support to our parish activities and building maintenance. The balance at the end of the fiscal year was \$2,010,270. This coming year we will have the added support of members that have joined us from the Chapel site without the corresponding expenses of maintaining the properties. We expect an influx of funds from the sale of these properties. In addition we will have an outlay of funds for the replacement of the roof and air conditioning unit for our Church building offset by ongoing receipts from the Beyond Sunday contributions.

It is our intent to continue with urgent efforts to balance our budget in the coming years. It will take great attention on all of us to continuing to grow our collections and reduce our parish expenditures. Plans have been prepared and put into action to raise additional funds through increased giving outreach, attracting new parishioners, continuing to rent our facilities to additional partners in providing services to our community, and new revenue from the cell tower rental agreement. We are striving to find new sources of revenue and support - and providing a firm foundation for our future as a strong Catholic presence in our expansive North County community.








