

CatholicFIT Continues Help Students Connect Faith and Fitness

For the 4th year, students in 3rd and 6th grades from all of our schools are participating in the CatholicFIT program. The 8-week program provides curriculum content for PE Class, exercise demonstration videos and a visit from Professional Fitness Trainer and CatholicFIT Creator, Dave Reddy. In the photo above, Mr. Reddy is leading the 3rd Grade PE Class at **Christ Light of the Nations School**. Each week, PE teachers share a new "Exercise of the Week" along with CatholicFIT principles that help them remember that they are each a beloved child of God and make the connection between their faith and fitness. This fall, CatholicFIT is in progress at All Saints Academy St. Ferdinand and St. Rose campuses, St. Ann and Christ Light of the Nations. The remaining schools will begin in February.

Trinity Receives Grant Award from Raskob Foundation!

Trinity Catholic High School received a \$10,000 grant from the Raskob Foundation to plan and implement a Trauma-Informed Care Program creating a healing and transformative school community. This planning grant is intended to cover the implementation phase of this project focusing on the introduction, assessment, training and implementing among faculty. Concrete strategies to be introduced:

- Faculty safety plan implementation
- Faculty self-care implementation
- Faculty community meeting structure implementation
- Introduction, assessment, and identification of student leaders for phase 2

This is an exciting project that will give concrete skills to our faculty and develop youth leadership in the areas of brain health, resilience and community formation



HOME IS WHERE THE FAMILY IS

The idea, dream, and reality of family is so strong and durable that we use it to describe all that is best about human gatherings. We speak of the family of nations, of our church and parish families. The greatest compliment we can pay a friend or gracious host is to say that we feel at home with them, we feel part of the family.

Families are the first crucibles in which love is tested and tempered. Jesus himself was one of three people who lived in the shadow of each other. This family, like our own, did not always “get it right,” but they always tried to. These three “amateurs” were on holiday, and one of them got lost. Two were worried sick and took great measures to find the third, a boy after all, who was seeking the meaning of his calling. He found his vocation—to do his Father’s work—but he also returned home with his parents.






