**ANNUALLY EVERY PARISH** participates in the Archdiocesan Mission Cooperation Plan designed to connect mission groups to parishes to speak about the work of our Church in other parts of the world. It's a good reminder for us all that our Church is fundamentally a Mission Church.

This plan, an initiative of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith in St. Louis, helps us learn more about the missionary activity of our Catholic Church in the United States and around the world.

There are **two great benefits for our Church** when we do this. First, every parish is enriched and strengthened when parishioners learn about how other people and parishes are practicing their faith, often in difficult circumstances. Second, our spiritual and material solidarity with mission parishes around the world enables them to exist and to grow. It's a two-way street! The mission sending and mission receiving character of a parish has long been considered an evidence of its health and well-being - its viability.

Please welcome to our parish this weekend Father Emile. He is a priest of the Diocese of Kumbo, Cameroon, in Africa, ordained in April 2014. In 2018 he was sent by his bishop to study systematic theology at St. Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore.

Father Emile will speak with us about the work of the Church in the Diocese of Edea, this year celebrating its 25th anniversary. This diocese has 35 parishes with 8 women religious congregations and 1 congregation of men providing support for the work of evangelization. They also now have an increasing number of priests serving parishes and 2 pilgrimage centers in support of their faith. Education, health, and human development are the focal points of pastoral and missionary activity through schools and colleges, hospitals and health centers, and social pastorals structures.

The Diocese of Edea is rapidly Growing. With very limited resources they have great need for financial assistance. Their greatest needs are for the work of evangelization, especially in very remote areas, and support for the increasing number of priests and vocations. Currently they receive support from the Vatican and are conducting fundraising within their own diocese. They also rely on support from parishes like ours around the world.

In the future the diocese hopes to open a center of agricultural transformation, targeting young single mothers who have dropped out of school because of hardship and uncontrolled disaster.

Please pray for and be as generous as you can be in support of the Diocese of Edea. And, encourage Father Emile in the work he is doing and in his hopes for the future.





## Mass Intentions & Stipends

In each of the four dioceses of our state parish priests are compensated in different ways. Most commonly their compensation and benefits are paid through the generosity of parishioners in the regular Offertory Collection. However, in smaller rural or poor parishes Mass stipends often make up for the difference between what a priest may need and what a parish can afford. For these reasons the bishops of Missouri recently decided that it would be good to have a standard practice regarding stipends. Stipend offerings are always voluntary and not required for a Mass intention. Historically, they "contribute to the good of the Church" and show "concern to support its ministers and works". (Canon 946) Beginning July 1st, 2019, the ordinary voluntary stipend offering associated with a Mass intention will be \$10.00 or any other amount at the donor's discretion. Our bishops are quite emphatic about reminding everyone of the well-honored practice of celebrating Mass even if no stipend is offered. Thanks to all for your continuing generous support and for your participation in the life of our parish. I know that everyone who works here is grateful for your commitment to the welfare and operation of our parish.
