

Parish Report from Father Mike

Sale of Parish Property in Spanish Lake - Part 2

Chapel of Our Lady and Parish Rectory

Last week I first reported that we have completed the sale of our parish properties on Bellefontaine Road in Spanish Lake. The details of that report were published in the weekend bulletin for July 21st. Copies of this report may also be found at all church entrances.

In summary, the sale price for these properties was \$750,000 which after expenses of \$46,473.76 resulted in a **\$703,526.24** increase in our parish savings. In addition, during the past fiscal year we incurred \$26,652 in parish expenses related to our ownership of the chapel and rectory, primarily property insurance, utilities, and maintenance of the grounds and buildings. These costs will not be expenses in the current fiscal year.

Please join me in thanking **Marty Bligh, Mike Petroff, and Steve Jones** for their careful attention to overseeing the maintenance and security of the chapel and rectory throughout the past year. They were also very helpful to our realtor in showing the property to prospective buyers. Their time and effort helped tremendously in achieving this goal in a relatively timely manner.

THIS ADDITION TO OUR PARISH SAVINGS

is important, even essential for our future. However, our financial stability and viability as a parish must continue to focus on achieving a balanced parish budget. Knowing why we are here and what we need to do as a parish must always guide how we manage our expenses and encourage increased offertory revenues. Thank you for your generous financial support for our parish and our mission.

VARIOUS FURNISHINGS and religious articles were donated to the following parishes:

Holy Martyrs of Japan Parish, where Fr. Tim Henderson serves as Pastor, received a tabernacle, monstrance used for adoration and benediction, and several wooden pedestals.

St. Philomena / Christ the King Parishes, Fr. Ray Iwuji's home parish and the last parish where he served before coming to America, will receive the following items when transportation to Nigeria can be arranged: tabernacle at the main altar, the stations of the cross, a processional cross, sacred vessels, & vestments.

St Joseph Parish (Manchester) requested and in the near future will use the main altar and ambo for their church.

Christ Light of the Nations School uses altar furnishings for Tolton Hall from the Adoration Chapel as well as vestments and sacred vessels.

Holy Name of Jesus Parish installed the statues of Mary and Joseph in The Commons of our Parish Office Center, the nativity set for our exterior Christmas display, and the piano in church for our music ministry.

The sale of these parish properties took place after our evaluation of parish plans first made in the spring of 2016. Parish leaders recommended to Archbishop Carlson in January 2018 that we formally close the Chapel of Our Lady as a worship site for Holy Name of Jesus Parish. In May 2018 we first put these parish properties on the market for sale. During the past year these parish properties attracted the active interest of three different church groups or congregations, resulting in this sale early in July of this year.
