

## **Thanking God for the Good Work We Are Given To Do**

### **With Hearts Full of Joy**

This past Sunday 450-500 people attended our **Mass Mob** liturgy celebrating the presence of our Catholic Church in this part of North County and the difference our practice of faith makes here and now on a daily basis. In the fellowship after Mass people connected with visitors and parishioners, renewing acquaintances and finding out more about our parish life and the work of our Church. I truly thank all who helped with the planning for this day, and for everyone who went the extra-mile to get the word out and invite family, friends, and neighbors to come and celebrate with us. It was certainly an uplifting and encouraging time for us all to be together. A great grace for us and for all who came to be with us in a spirit of prayer and recommitment.

### **Progress Report - An Update on Hiring for Our Parish Maintenance Position**

As you may recall at the end of June we announced that **Steve Jones** would become a part time parish employee and would retire at the end of the year. Steve has served as Parish Maintenance Coordinator for almost 15 years and has been a great help to me in meeting the challenges of parish administration. With his help we've established a viable parish in this community - now and for years to come. He has supported and worked closely with other parish leaders, service providers, and contractors to insure our buildings are in good shape and our systems are efficient. His skills and good judgment have helped us to be good stewards of our buildings and of our parish financial resources.

In early August we actively began our search for someone to replace Steve. With our Finance Committee, Pastoral Leadership Team, and Human Resource Office of the Archdiocese, we finalized and posted a position description for a new maintenance coordinator. As a result we received 11 inquiries about the position for which we then received 7 applications. A small committee then reviewed and discussed these applications and scheduled 4 applicants for personal interviews. We then offered the position to one candidate whose qualifications meet our expectations for the position.

Two weeks ago I then met with this candidate for a second interview and discussion about the position, which he

found especially attractive because of our parish mission and plans for our Catholic Church to make a difference in this part of North County. However, after taking some time to talk with his family and fairly consider changing jobs, we met again this week and he declined our offer of employment.

Therefore, we again are posting the position opening and are inviting anyone who may be interested to apply. (*See the general position description in the box below.*)

I would encourage any parishioners who may be interested to carefully look over this information and to apply. You may also know someone who you think may be interested and has the qualifications. By all means pass this information on to them.
