

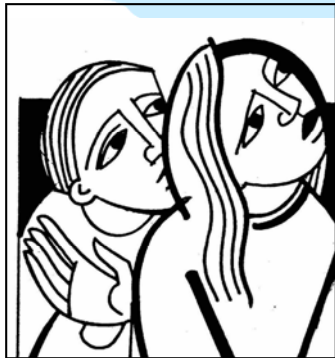

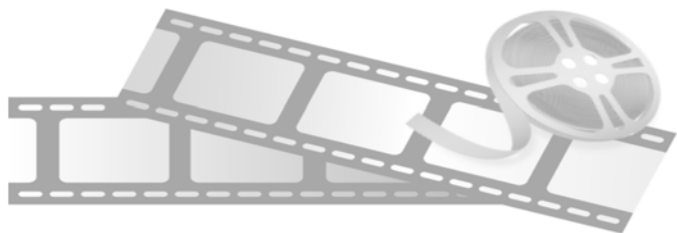

### Diversity & Inclusion Survey and Focus Groups for Parishioners and Stakeholders
