

living in a time of closed gates
it's for our own good! really?

Last weekend Christian communities around the world celebrated Good Shepherd Sunday. It's one of the earliest and oldest images adopted by believers for understanding and telling others about Jesus. It helps many to know how much we are loved by God and that God is with us even through the most difficult times.

A few days before, I received a letter from, David Thomas, one of my former teachers. He has about 10 years of age on me. I've learned a lot from his wisdom and experience in life. So I'd like to share with you part of his letter.

"We are living through a time that could hardly have been imagined. Terrible tragedies have befallen so many." In all this "I do see some positives for us personally. Like a time to reconsider just about everything in our lives - what we do each day, what's really important, what we have taken for granted but should not have, how we might live differently for the rest of our days, what do we really need to be happy, who is my neighbor ... a great list of things assumed, but now we know they shouldn't be."

This year John the Evangelist plays with the image of Jesus, the Good Shepherd. (Remember the imagination often takes us into a more mysterious world.) John has Jesus proclaim to the disciples - ourselves included - not only, "**I AM the Good Shepherd!**", but also, "**I AM the gate!**" Jesus is the one who secures us within the safety of the enclosure designed for our welfare, for our good when we need it.

Whether I like it or not - and I have tested the point of it all - "stay at home" orders are for my good and for yours. The sense of safety and security can be a blessing as much as our freedom of movement and need to be somewhere else. There is a comfort for me in knowing that Jesus isn't just at the gate, he is the gate! In the comfort of that space David seeks to find something positively good. He concludes with this.

"And there's a bunch of oddities that have come forth - like forgetting what day it is, or what to do with increased quiet, or asking again, what are the blessings I receive each day that that I don't recognize as such. Still, the days and night pass - but still, it's not the same. It feels at times that we have migrated to a different planet."

This mysterious world we're now in is a matter of fact and a moment of faith. In ways that are obvious and others which might only be found with effort, the world we're now in is for our own good. Please try the spiritual exercise this week and let me know how it goes for you. Drop me a note or letter if you feel so moved. I still have much to learn and there are many teachers in my life yet today.

But, what better gift might we give back to God than our being different, better people because of all this.

IMPACT TO DATE

- ◆ **40% Parish Share of Campaign Funds Raised**

\$96,898 received by our parish representing 76% of an expected total benefit to our parish of \$127,924 (40% of the \$319,811 gifts and pledges initially received from our parishioners)

As proposed in our campaign statement these funds partially covered the now completed replacement of roofs on our parish church and rectory, helping to conserve our parish Reserve Fund (Savings).

- ◆ **Beyond Sunday Scholarships**

\$34,250 in scholarships awarded to 7 Catholic students in our parish

- ◆ **Beyond Sunday Grants**

\$275,000 in grants awarded to our own and all Federation schools of our Deanery in 2018 for technology in education, in 2019 for diversity and inclusion programs, and in 2020 for a shared technology library.

\$96,898 has been returned to our parish from the total amount of gifts received & pledges already fulfilled by our parishioners - **\$242,244**


