






Today we are re-printing the first of three articles first published here last February. Under the title **Civilize It!** Catholic across the United States are once again being encouraged and challenged to be faithful citizens. In particular, this means being politically engaged in the conversations about social issues, Catholic teaching and values, and choices we can make for the present and future good of all in our nation and beyond.

Since February we may have become all the more aware of our need to be informed and active. 
