

# Our Lady of Perpetual Help

A Mosaic Reproduction of 15th Century Byzantine Icon

Feast Day of the Image - June 27th

## Historical Notes

In the Eastern Orthodox Church the icon is known as the “*Virgin Theotokos (Mother of God) of the Passion*” due to the instruments of the Passion of Jesus Christ present on the image.

## Unlocking the Code of the Icon

### The Blessed Virgin Mary

wears a dress of dark red, in Byzantine iconography the color of the empress, the Queen.

She looks toward the faithful while pointing at her son, Jesus Christ, who is frightened by the instruments of crucifixion and is depicted with a fallen sandal.

She has a star on her forehead signifying her role as Star of the Sea while the cross on the side has been claimed as referring to

the Greek monastery which produced the icon.

Her slender nose, thin lips, and smoothly arched eyebrows reveal evidence a Greek artist created the original. Her veil and face are rounded, indicating holiness.

Her size is out of proportion to her son, a deliberate intent by the artist to show Mary as larger than life.

The gold background represents the Kingdom of God.

**Saint Michael the Archangel** (left side) carries the lance and sponge of the crucifixion of Jesus.

**Saint Gabriel the Archangel** (right side) carries a 3-bar cross and nails.

### The Greek Monograms

below have been incorporated into the icon identifying images portrayed for the contemplation of the viewer:

**MP-ΘΥ**

(*Mother of God*) in the upper left and right corners

**OAM**

(*Michael the Archangel*) on the left side above the angel

**OΑΓ**

(*Gabriel the Archangel*) on the right side above the angel

**IC-XC**

(*Jesus Christ*) on the right side below the angel

We invite you to come forward to view the icon more closely and spend some time in prayer with this image of Mary. Devotions honoring her as **Mother of Perpetual Help** take place every Tuesday after the 8:00 am Mass.



## Shrine Design and Fabrication

The Shrine was constructed using salvaged sections of the pews originally installed in St. Jerome Parish church (1959).

## Rich Dean, Restorations Plus

Under the leadership of Michele Bowman with 30 years of conservation experience, with project support from Rich Dean, Restorations Plus specializes in refinishing Catholic statues, religious art, and church furnishings including plaster, wood, marble, metal, fiberglass, and canvas restorations. They provide decorative and liturgical design services for churches and offer consultation on marble and limestone religious statuary.

## Cameron Fuller, Workhorse Productions

Cameron is the founder of the Institute for Perpetual Imaginal Processes and works as an exhibit technician for the St. Louis Science Center. His artistic creations have been exhibited in St. Louis area galleries. Fuller sees folk art and Native American artifacts as touchstones. For these early cultures, art was a part of everyday life. “*There was a point in time when culture was steeped in artwork. We’ve become detached from art as a vital force in life – people can go their whole lives without buying a single piece of art.*” Cameron strives to remind us to use our imagination.

**SAINT MONICA (332-387)**

**August 27**

She had smiles for the neighbors, though her husband found her religion and the charity it inspired annoying. She made tearful prayers in private for a son, outwardly self-assured but, as his mother knew, inwardly restless, and whose girlfriend of a dozen years had borne his child out of wedlock. Though not the first or last such mother and son, Monica and Augustine are the Church's most famous, so we keep their feast days back to back, with Monica's, fittingly, first. To Rome she followed Augustine, then to Milan, where years of prayer—and nagging—finally bore fruit in his conversion by Saint Ambrose. For six months, mother and son enjoyed the blessing of rediscovering each other. Just in time! On the way home to North Africa, Monica took sick and died near Rome. No child who has mourned a parent can read, unmoved, Augustine's tender account, in his *Confessions*, of Monica's last days. At this time of the year, when parents watch apprehensively as children leave for school, may Monica's perseverance and Augustine's long-prayed-for conversion ease anxiety and kindle hope.
