

mission notes

we are a mission parish with a mission

from father mike / may 16th, 2021

there is great power – in the name of jesus

in service to our community becoming a vaccination center

After the resurrection of Jesus his disciples were still a “wounded” community. They were wounded and weakened by Judas’ treachery, by Peter’s betrayal, and by their own fears and cowardice. They felt failure, held false expectations, and pursued personal ambitions. They wanted quick solutions. Yet, Mark’s Jesus still believes in them and calls them to a mission beyond the boundaries of Jerusalem to the very ends of the Earth.

Today, in the absence of Jesus’ physical presence among us, we are the people entrusted with the mission of proclaiming the Gospel. We too are sent to do new wonders, speak new words with passion and conviction, offer new healing to our sisters and brothers, and cast out contemporary “demons” from ourselves and others. All this continues to be ***“in the name of Jesus”***. Baptized into His Body, the community of the Church, we must never forget that **we personally share the power of Jesus for the sake of a mission of healing and hope.**

proof of faith moments

Every day each of us and our community as a whole are given opportunities for testing out and strengthening our power of faith in the name of Jesus who remains really presence with us. Last week our parish was invited to become a Covid-19 vaccination site in this part of North St. Louis County. The pace of vaccinations has dropped off and the effort to vaccinate is now shifting its focus. For weeks, health departments have been reevaluating their strategies, moving toward more small events within communities and redoubling their efforts to make vaccine doses as easy to find as possible, getting them directly to neighborhoods of greatest need.

Vaccination data suggests that residents in North St. Louis and North St. Louis County have received the Covid-19 vaccines in lower rates than the rest of the region. Roughly 70% to 80% of the adult population remains unvaccinated. In addition, as children become eligible for the vaccine and the real hope of their returning to in person school attendance grows stronger, the need for accessible vaccination sites becomes all the more needed.

I believe that **our parish**, our faith community, is **being called to this mission of healing and hope**. The challenges may seem great and they will be. Making medical care accessible to our neighbors,

building awareness and trust, and adjusting our lives to the realities and schedules of those most in need may be difficult. But it will also be a **credible evidence of our Church’s real presence and power in the community.**

If this is what you believe, then you may already be feeling the desire to participate. If so, read on to learn more about what would be expected of us. Seriously pray about this. If you want to be a part of the effort, contact our Parish Office and let us know.

expected of us

what our parish will do

We have been invited to become a Covid-19 vaccine distribution center for all who live in the general community of our parish. The St. Louis County Department of Public Health (DPH) is providing detailed guidance for this event as well as the technical and clinical support needed for the day of the event itself.

In order for our parish to apply to become a vaccine site we need **two contact persons** who will work with DPH to prepare for the day. **Our parish community**—with the help of these two coordinators of the event—**will:**

Recruit participants and schedule their appointments prior to the event

Ensure an organizational point person is on site for the duration of the event

Recruit volunteers to staff non-medical roles

Ensure point person and volunteers arrive no later than one hour prior to the event

Provide physical space adequate for people to be vaccinated and complete the mandatory post-vaccination monitoring period while adhering to social distancing

Have adequate parking spaces with easy in and out access (FEMA guideline recommend about 50 parking spaces for every 100 appointments per day)

Provide basic facility amenities (electricity, water, restrooms, HVAC, Wi-Fi, etc.)

Provide basic equipment such as tables and chairs.






