**EVANGELIZATION NEWS  
FROM THE DESK OF  
SISTER MARY LAWRENCE,  
SSND**

Several weeks ago, I wrote about the plaques by each of the doors of church that identify the four virtues or characteristics of a Catholic/Christian person, family organization or parish: **Community, Gospel Values, Worship and Service.** I then focused on the virtue of Community.

This week I would like to highlight the second virtue: **Gospel Values. Gospel Values are what Jesus said, what Jesus did and what He told us to do.**

... All of the Gospel values begin with and 'derive from Jesus' Law of Love and are a perfect example for how we should follow in His footsteps as Catholic/Christians.

You might ask: What are the Gospel Values that I should be living each day? Here are a few:

***Respect for the Life and Dignity of Each Individual, Love, Trust in God, Hope, Honesty, Compassion, Forgiveness, Mercy, Justice, Peace, Simplicity, Service, and Friendship.***

Each of us models these gospel values by how we live our lives. The evangelist Matthew ended his gospel with the story of Jesus ascending into heaven saying, **“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of time.”**

When we live and model these Gospel Values, we are bringing Jesus to ALL the people we come in contact with. Evangelization (sharing those values) is our mission as a Catholic/ Christian. Thank you for taking on that mission of bringing the Good News to everyone you meet!

Lenten Fish Fries are returning beginning on Ash Wednesday, March 2, and every Friday in Lent except for March 4.




