

I am most grateful for the generosity of our parishioners once again this year in your prayer, gifts, and pledges in support of our **Annual Catholic Appeal**. More than any other Archdiocesan initiative the Appeal **demonstrates the power for good** that can be accomplished when parishes commit themselves to **working together**.

One verse from today's Gospel has held my attention all week. St. Luke seems to have written it as a **summary** of his whole Gospel message and as a **spring board** into the energy and activity of the Acts of the Apostles. In one verse, I think he's answering the questions, **How does a disciple of Jesus live? Where do disciples come from?**

"Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem."

Feast of the Ascension, Gospel of Luke 24: 46-53

"Preaching forgiveness" is an ever-growing commitment to **unconditional love** which is the **essential element** for anyone wanting to **turn their life around ("repentance")** and a **powerful attraction** for anyone on Earth in need or wanting to exercise its power on behalf of others.

We are quite close to our **fundraising goal** for this year, and even a small gift will help us achieve our **participation goal** as a parish.

This past week I was contacted by the **Urban League of St. Louis** as well as a neighboring pastor inviting our parish to participate in a community outreach initiative that has taken place over the past several years.

The project is called **Grill to Glory**. It's a highly visible, high-impact, neighborhood engagement model designed to challenge and change the culture in urban neighborhoods. The purpose is to re-engineer neighborhoods and make the neighborhood Church a focal point for individuals and neighborhood families.

Grill to Glory invites neighborhood residents to neighborhood Churches every Saturday for food and spirited-filled fellowship. Done consistently and in unity, **Grill to Glory** will go a long way towards restoring civility in neighborhoods, the community, and America. In partnership with neighborhood Churches, the Urban League is working to kick-off **Grill to Glory** on Saturday, **June 18th, 2022**—in celebration of **Juneteenth Day**.

As we look to the future I believe this invitation has also come to us from God who imagines and encourages our participation and the difference it will make. If so, I think we need a commitment to two things:

Organizational Leadership—Two persons willing to work with a small team and parish volunteers, and

Consistency of Effort—Maybe not every Saturday, but often enough to have an impact in our community.
