

solidarity in the mission of the church

Annually every parish participates in the **Archdiocesan Mission Cooperation Plan** designed to connect mission groups to parishes to speak about the work of our Church in other parts of the world. It's a good reminder for us all that our Church is fundamentally a Mission Church.



This plan, an initiative of the Society of the Propagation of the Faith in St. Louis, helps us learn more about the missionary activity of our Catholic Church in the United States and around the world. There are **two great benefits for our Church** when we do this.

First, every parish is **enriched and strengthened** when parishioners learn about how other people and parishes are practicing their faith, often in difficult circumstances.

Second, our **spiritual and material solidarity with mission parishes** around the world enables them to exist and to grow.

It's a two-way street! The mission sending and mission receiving character of a parish has long been considered an evidence of its health and well-being - its viability.

This year please join me in welcoming to our parish this weekend **Father Antony Muthu**. He is a priest of the Diocese of Kumbakonam, India, founded in 1899 and

a 25% larger geographic area than the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Father Antony has been serving in the United States for nearly 20 years.

Due to acute poverty 65% of the Catholics of this diocese depend primarily on funds from their mission appeals for their pastoral, educational, medical, and socio-economic work of evangelization of the poor.

Their most pressing missionary needs include establishing 8 new parishes, supporting Catholic schools and orphanages, and operating hospitals for children and adults, and seminaries. A range of their funding needs are listed below.

Years ago a young child asked me, "*Father, where do Catholics come from?*" As we talked about this question with her classmates, I remember how happy they were to learn that Catholics come from everywhere. The Acts of the Apostles also celebrates that anybody from anywhere can be a Christian.

Once the Apostles understood this and took it seriously, the Church began to grow. And it's ever been this way! Jesus only asks for two things: Love yourself and your neighbor—**be the best human being you possibly can be**. And, love God—**make it personal**. After that the Holy Spirit will help you to see in our members and complete strangers what's most needed by our Church today. 




