

Since July 2017 our parish has had a partnership with St. Francis Community Services—an agency of Catholic Charities—to sponsor the *Pathways to Progress Initiative*. This ministry strives to strengthen our community by **helping families increase their ability** —

- (\*) to live safe, productive, and sustainable lives;
- (\*) to make effective decisions that positively impact their future; and
- (\*) to advocate for systemic and progressive change in support of their stability and long-term economic independence.

Member families **commit themselves** to effectively utilizing *Pathways'* services in order to break the cycle of poverty in their lives now—and for the sake of their children in the future.

reporting success  
making connections

For the past 5 years I have served on *Pathway's* Community Advisory Board. This Board strives to function as an effective networking organization in support of the work of this ministry. Every family that makes a commitment to work on the challenges (\*) noted above, needs and deserves a similar commitment from our community and our Church.

At the Board's August meeting *Pathways* had 9 full time employees working with the 75 member families currently enrolled in this initiative of which 20 live in the City of St. Louis and 55 in St. Louis County. There are a total of 200 children in the families now being served.

Finally, in early August 11 families were in the screening process for acceptance as members before the end of this year. With an increasing case load they are now hiring more Member Advisors.

*Pathways'* administrative offices are located in our parish Community Center and their member advisors all have offices there, though they are often in the field assisting families.

In support of those families *Pathways* offers twice monthly education and training workshops in the cafeteria and takes advantage of the on-site services of **St. Louis Counseling**—another agency of Catholic Charities—located in our Parish Office Center.

Please join me in prayer for each of these families. May they be gifted in the good will of others and with the graces of perseverance, courage, peace of mind and heart, patience, and gratitude for blessings received.

*Pathways* strives to surround each of them with all the services and support they need to achieve what they really want! May our community surround them also with faithful love and an equally generous willingness to support these families as well.

This coming Thursday, September 8th, *Pathways* will hold its 3rd graduation ceremony for 13 member families who have successfully achieved their goals. This marks a formal completion of their work with *Pathways*, though this network of support will continue to be available to them as needed.

At the table of the Lord each week we celebrate the bonds connecting us and make them stronger. Making such a difference in the lives of others all begins with you. Our partnership with *Pathways* includes talking with your neighbors, friends, or family who truly might benefit from this initiative.

**YOUR EVANGELIZATION TEAM IS COMPLETING THEIR GOALS**

The Evangelization Team has developed 11 goals for their first year which began in November. The Team has spent time learning about evangelization by a book study, and other input on-line. They have completed several of their goals already and are in process with the rest.

A few of our **completed goals** are:

**Starting up Adoration** again since COVID

**Creating Greeters** for Sunday Masses Placed “We’re Here For You” **doorhangers** on 50 doors on Ashbrook to reach out to the neighborhood

**Called 210 parishioners** who we haven’t had any contact with to check on them and update their contact information. The parishioners that we could not reach by phone, we sent self-addressed stamped envelopes and the information sheet for them to return in the mail.

We **held a “Painting the Sacred Within” class.** 22 parishioners and friends attended. It was a

great community building event.

Held our first **Grandparents Association** meeting with grandparents and their grandchildren. As a service project, they made sandwiches for St. Vincent DePaul Church for the homeless, had pizza and played games. The evening was enjoyed by all who attended.

Beginning this week our new **Spiritual Reading Library** will be available for you to check out books. Please sign the card in the front pocket and leave it in the basket. Return the card to the book and reshelve it when finished. We’ve only just started to gather books for our library. More will be available soon. The library is in a bookcase inside the gates to the Adoration Room.

Be watching for other opportunities to participate in parish life.




