

The Good is the Enemy of the Best

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

Laudetur Jesus Christus, In Saecula Saeculorum! Today, as we gather on this Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time, we embark on a captivating journey into the symbolic world of a magnificent banquet. It serves as a powerful representation of the abundant blessings that God bestows upon us. Through the prophetic words of Isaiah (Isaiah 25:6-10) and the gracious invitation of Jesus (Matthew 22:1-14), we are invited to partake in the profound and all-embracing call to join the lavish feast of the Kingdom.

At first glance, the story seems predictable. A king prepares a grand feast, yet those initially invited refuse to attend. We might anticipate that the king would then replace them with more deserving guests, those who meet certain criteria of righteousness. But to our surprise, the king's servants gather both the good and the bad from the streets, welcoming all into the banquet.

This turn of events raises questions within us. Isn't goodness the prerequisite for entering the eternal banquet? Doesn't Jesus Himself say, "Many are invited, but few are chosen"? We may find ourselves struggling to comprehend the mysterious workings of God's kingdom, but perhaps that is precisely the point.

Let us consider two key insights from this parable. **Firstly**, when Jesus speaks of only a few being chosen, He challenges us to rise above complacency and mediocrity. <u>His forceful language serves as a wake-up call, urging us to strive for excellence in our faith journey. By embracing love, hope, and mercy, we can truly experience the fullness of life that God Intends for us.</u>

Secondly, the inclusion of both the good and the bad in the banquet teaches us that God's salvation is not bound by human standards. It is God who determines who is worthy, and we must resist the temptation to play God ourselves. Our salvation is not earned through our own efforts or merits; it is a gift of grace bestowed upon us by a loving and merciful God.

In light of these insights, let us accept the invitation to the divine banquet with humility and gratitude. We are called to live lives infused with love, kindness, and generosity, not as a means to earn our place at the feast, but as a response to the overwhelming love of our Creator. May we embrace this opportunity to live beyond our expectations and to journey with God throughout our earthly lives and into eternity.

**Prayer:** Oh, Almighty One, we are aware of your boundless affection for us, extending an open invitation to partake in the grand celebration of the Lamb. Grant us the strength to wholeheartedly embrace your love, so that we may not only bear the title of your Son's followers, but truly embody it in every aspect of our lives. Amen! **Have a blessed Week!**




